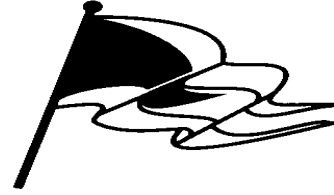

## *Amendment A to the 2017 Sailing Instructions*

- 1.0 This amendment applies to the Shark Class only, and for the Ravine Vineyard, Clan MacLeod, Great Laker, and Brox Company 1812 Series' only.
- 2.0 The NOLSC/YYC 2017 Sailing Instructions, are hereafter referred to as the "SI's"
- 3.0 Following section 5.3 add:
  - 5.4 "For the Shark class only, it will be the intent of the race committee to run two (2) races per evening". This applies to the Ravine Vineyard, Clan MacLeod, and Great Laker Series only.
- 4.0 The SI's section 7.2 (b) will be changed to read: "For the Shark Class, mark 'a' will be a red ball, (mark "P").
- 5.0 The SI's section 8.9 will be changed to read: "The starting and finishing marks will be the race committee signal vessel at the starboard end and a red tetrahedron for the PHRF classes, and a white ball (mark "U") for the Shark class at the port end"
- 6.0 The SI's section 10 "Change of the next leg of the course" will be changed in its entirety to read:

For the Shark class only, course changes will be announced on VHF channel 71.

The Race Committee will announce the Shark class as many as three times, Followed by identifying itself as the Race Committee.

Example: “Shark class Shark class Shark class, this is the Race Committee”  
The Race Committee will then announce the new bearing and distance to the next mark. This announcement will be repeated.

**7.0** After SI’s sections 12.1, and 12.2, add sections 12.1A and 12.2A respectively, to read:

**12.1A:** For the Shark class, the time limit for the first boat in class is one (1) hour from the class starting signal.

**12.2A:** For the Shark class, boats failing to finish within 15 minutes of the first boat to finish will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing.

**8.0** The SI’s section 14 “Scoring”, after section 14.1, add the following:

**14.1A** For the Ravine Vineyard and Great Laker Series, if either nine (9) or ten (10) races have been sailed, a boat’s score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores. If six (6) to eight (8) races have been sailed, a boat’s score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst single score. If fewer than six (6) races have been sailed, a boat’s score will be the total of her race scores.

For the Clan MacLeod series, if six (6) to eight (8) races have been sailed, a boat’s score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst single score. If fewer than six (6) races have been sailed, a boat’s score will be the total of her race scores.
